Another sweet treat was scheduled for dessert, it was the Domains Schlumberger Pinot Gris Cuvée Clarisse SGN (Sélection de Grains Nobles) 2000. This very rare wine made from nobly rotten grapes has only seen three other bottlings in 1964, 1989 and 1997. At least another ten years of cellaring is recommended for this late harvest wine although, at the moment it is impressing with great balance on the palate.
