


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STEVEN SPURRIER'S CHOICE:

DOMAINES SCHLUMBERGER Pinot Gris Grand Cru Kitterlé 2001

Domaines Schlumberger's four grand cru vineyards cover 70 ha of its 140 ha estate, and Kitterlé is the best site for Pinot Gris. With explosively rich, spicy, unctuous fruit yet a dryish finish, this is a triumphant wine from a great vintage. Marvellous now, but will keep a decade.
