



**Pinot Gris**  
**Cuvée Clarisse 1999**  
**Sélection de grains Nobles**  
**95 / 100**

A pure, beautifully structured wine, with layers of dry botrytis delicately poised over mangoes and spice. Intriguing because it is both sweet and dry at the same time, a great balancing act, and it manages to retain varietal character, hard to do with sweet wines.

**Pinot Gris**  
**Grand Cru Kessler 2001**  
**95 / 100**

This Pinot Gris shows sweetness, some honey but also a fine mineral structure, which promises aging at least for 10 years.

**Pinot Gris**  
**Grand Cru Kitterlé 2002**  
**94 / 100**

A beautiful wine, balancing acidity, spice and fresh peach flavors with structure and ageability. This brings out all the characters of great Pinot Gris, elegance and power combining in harmony.

**Pinot Gris**  
**Grand Cru Spiegel 2002**  
**91 / 100**

A full fresh wine, with very ripe, apricot fruit. This is generous, packed with spice and lychee flavours and with fine balancing acidity.

**Pinot Gris**  
**Vendanges Tardives 1998**  
**89 / 100**

Honey, toast marmalade combine in this delicately sweet wine. There are currant flavours, acidity, herbs and some spice. A fine wine that remains fresh and crisp.

**Pinot Gris**  
**Les Princes Abbés 2002**  
**88 / 100**

A blend from a number of its vineyards, this is a dry wine, with fresh acidity and white currant flavours. A great aperitif wine, but also good with fish or salads.
