## DOMAINES SCHLUMBERGER Riesling Les Princes Abbés 2000 91/100

With 345 acres under vine, the Schlumberger family controls the largest contiguous estate in Alsace. Half of the vineyards are in *grands crus* sites. The Riesling grapes for this white come from several different parcels on the proprety. It is fermented in oak, then transferred to stainless steel to retain freshness. Séverine Beydon-Schlumberger, the seventh generation, comanages the estate with her uncle, Alain Beydon-Schlumberger.
